POLICY

As part of our medical humanitarian mission, MSF is committed to transparency and to sharing broadly the knowledge gained from research and experience at our projects. Wide dissemination of our work helps promote health benefits for underserved populations and enhances our accountability to the populations we serve and the donors who support our work. Journal paywalls that impose subscription or article fees to access content are incompatible with these commitments, and with promoting equity in research. For this reason, MSF requires that journal articles containing data from our medical projects, and/or with significant contributions from MSF authors, are published in journals that provide free online access to the work at the time of publication.
