Noma - a neglected disease


- High mortality rates if not treated
- High levels of re-admission or loss to follow up

Solution: Noma Discharge Toolkit (NDT)

The strength is in the person centred process







Sapling Nursery Fund

Person/Patient Centered Approach


- Ex. Patient journey mapping, stakeholder analysis, interviews, workshops, group sessions.
- Main problem: what happens after discharge?















The Noma Discharge Toolkit (NDT)


- Booklet (stories to transfer knowledge)
- Nutrition
- Non-Food Items (NFI)
- Medication and treatment

Inclusion and integration

- All hospital staff, focal points in communities, caregivers play a role








So far:

20 patients and caregivers have received the NDT

Assessment

- Feedback from staff and caregivers
- Monitor re-admissions and follow ups









Lessons learned and next steps

- Person centred approaches take time.
- Feedback is important for understanding impact
- Ex. 1 month replenishment of consumables
- Next steps: Assess data, adapt and explore how to integrate the NDT into Sokoto Noma project
